 [)etainee described the relationship between Si in Tal 'Afar and Mosul.



Detainee did not know where Abu Basha'ir or Abu Basha'ir's family lived.

Detainee had no knowledge on where Abu Qaswarah's family resided. Detainee only knew Abu Qaswarah's name and had not met him or visited his residence.

Detainee left Tai 'Afar in June 2007 and did not return prior to his DOC.

The Wali in Tall 'Afar is Abu Rahim, upon whom Detainee has already given information. The Shari'a amir is Abu Mahdi.

The Waliand Shari'a amir for Tai 'Afar have stopped fighters from Tai 'Afar going to Mosul and Haydar al 'Afri was due to move to Tai 'Afar from Mosul just as he was killed by CF. Detainee used these two examples of recent events (up to one month PDOC) to illustrate that ISi in Tai 'Afar was suffering from a lack of skilled and experienced fighters and that movement of such fighters to Mosul would be detrimental to the fight in Tai 'Afar. Whilst there is a good relationship between the two groups, there is no excessive collaboration.
