Content of Request

To the brother, the wali of al-Raqqah, may God preserve you. Peace be upon you, God’s mercy and His blessings. And as to what follows:

I am [redacted]. ‘Abdul-Salam ‘Abdul-Latif, who used to work as labor in the fortifications, came to me and offered me a project to work with the brothers in the fortifications, on the condition that we pledge to do the work at our own expense and that I finance the project with an amount of 3 to 4 million in supplies and equipment, and that the brothers give us the price of the supplies on credit and pay for it in installments from the existing work. After working for a year and 4 months, the brothers collected the price of the equipment from our work, and the agreement was that we would write the contract after the brothers had paid the price of the equipment. I asked him to go to the administration for our money, but I was surprised that he had written the contract between him and the brothers from the date of the start of work. I would like to inform you that I asked him from the beginning of the work to write the contract and he told me that Abu ‘Umar Al-Homsi does not allow writing a contract for security reasons, and we should not talk about it. They said that our rights are preserved with them and they are trustworthy. This was a lie and has no credibility. Then we differed as a result of the subject of the contract and the money spent without knowing where this money was spent. He claimed that I worked for him (to be continued)
