I answered, "If you want my ID, come with me and I'll give it to you. If you are in the security, contact a brother in the security who knows me. His name is Ali." Then he started screaming again and said, "Who is Ali?" Then, Bariq said, "It is up to me. I can search any car I want, and I can catch and search whoever I want." My friend [redacted] said to him, "We are fasting and dizzy and you have been tiring us. What exactly you want?" Muhsin replied, "Are you fasting for me?" I said to him, "By God, leave us alone." And I pushed my friends away from them [to avoid trouble]. Then Bariq said, "By God, if it wasn't Ramadan, I wouldn't leave you alone." Then my friends and the security personnel each one went their way.
