Six months ago, I sold a car to the defendant for the sum of (\$1,800).

In return, he gave to me a rifle + magazines for the amount of (275 + 400 thousand + \$200), and the amount he owed me was about (\$700). Since then, he has not paid the amount, knowing that he has to be reported to traffic complaints and he refuses to attend. We do not know where he lives. Note that he is the emir of one of the frontlines in a checkpoint. He says that he will not pay me the debt until I transfer the ownership of the car to him. Note that when he bought it, it was not a condition of transfer. Also, everyone knows that there is no [ownership] transferring [system] since the establishment of the State of the Caliphate.

Please review this complaint, and hope that you will inform us of the result.
