Subject: A Complaint

I am the Muslim, [REDACTED]. I came to complain against brother Abu Ibbi who works in the Islamic State, in the Diwan of Hisbah. I own a generator in al-Sadah and 'Awizah, near Abu Mus'ab al-Zarqawi Mosque. I run the generator, based on a memo issued by the Islamic State, from 1 PM until 12 AM. The Muslim locals, who live in the area, asked me to run it from 12 PM until 12 AM, which means to run an extra hour for 1000 extra dinar. I also have a night shift, from 1 AM until 4 AM. Some of those participants in the day shift are not participants in the night shift. I have no right to remove this extra hour from the day shift to add it to the night shift. Abu Ibbi came to me and told me, "You are falsely taking Muslims' money." Knowing that I receive the amount of 10,500 dinars for the night and day shifts. After arguing about this matter, he said to me:

- 1- Your lower garment trails. [in Salafi Muslim doctrine, male Muslims should not have their pants/garment lower than specific height].
- 2- Your haircut is uneven.
- 3- Your beard is not long enough.

On that day, he went to my house and found my mother there. He told her, "Either your sons come, I'll break your car windows or you give me your car keys." Her blood pressure and sugar level went high. He said to my mother, "I will imprison your sons and they would never see the sunlight until they die of scabies."

Two days ago, I brought him a summons from the Generators' Committee because the problem is about pricing and shares. I said to him, "Brother, have you been informed about the summons?" He answered me loudly, "I would not go with the likes of you." I said to him, "I fear God, the Almighty and I would not dare to mock a dog or a monkey. How dare you say something like this and you are a Hisbah representative?" He said to me, "I have the right to hold you accountable even if you were Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi." He shamed me before the people in the street. All this problem because he wants me to run [the generator] from 1 AM until 6 AM.

May God reward you the best.
