Q1- How much do you know Dr. Abu Ali Al-Jarrah?

A1- I was resident [doctor] with him in al-Mayadin Hospital after he left Raqqa for about seven months [illegible] and I was the only resident with him in the hospital until the brothers left Raqqa.

Q2- How was his dealing with you and how was his dealing with patients and health staff?

A2- He was trying as hard as he could to hide the information completely [from us] and he never tried to teach us. He also hides the videos of the operations that we have. As for the sick and injured, he was doing his job to the fullest, regardless of the circumstances and the time.

Q3- What do you know about his property?

A3- He was telling me that he had nothing but these plates and screws and asked me not to talk about it so it wouldn't become an epidemic. However, after leaving Raqqa, they told me that these plates and screws were not his, but were purchased by order when he was with them in Raqqa, and the witness is Dr. Abu Muhammad Nur al-Qurashi.

Q4- What did he take with him of money and medical supplies when he left the Islamic State?

A4- I knew that he had a car of a type [illegible], a laptop, an M16, binoculars, and a complete maxillofacial and jaws kit. When he escaped, he kept some of the materials and plates in Hajin Hospital. I estimate what Jassim al-Mutar (Dr. Abu Ali al-Jarrah) took by the lost items that were discovered by each of the brothers, Dr. Saifullah [illegible] and Dr. Abu Muhammad Nur Al-Qurashi.

Q5- Did he have money belonging to the Islamic State?

A5- Before he left, he asked Dr. Abu 'Umar Al-Homsi to pay bills worth... [I think the rest of the complaint text is available in another page].
