[Illegible] I needed some medicine, but I could not find it, so I learned from the emir of warehouses, Abul-Zubayr al-Maghribi, that it might be available in the women's hospital, as I am in charge of the pharmacy department in Hajin. So, I went to the hospital to get the medicine because we really needed the medicine that day, but the sister [first name of the sister is illegible] 'Abdul-Rahman al-Tunisi prevented me from entering the pharmacy. She said: 'I do not allow you to enter without a letter from the emir sector or the Medical emir, and I do not allow you to withdraw any medicine. So, I went to brother Abu Suhayb, because he was her husband, and he was the one who received the medicines from me to the Women's Hospital, but he told me the same what his wife said. Thus, I could not take the medicine on that day which is the specified date for taking the medicine. Thus, the sister and her husband have caused us harm. Then, I complained to the emir of the hospital, brother Abu Dhar, and told him about this matter, and he gave me a letter to enter the pharmacy, which is under my authority. The sister, after reading the letter, asked me to bring a letter whenever I wanted to come to the pharmacy, with the warning that no medicine was withdrawn from the pharmacy without a letter, knowing that they received the medicines in an external and urgent envelope without inventory and without signing the receipt at the time of the bombing of Hajin.
