- Detainee provided a layout of Abu Qaswarah's camp and described how one of the two Toyota pick-ups is stored inside the tent.

- Detainee failed to recognize the name Ustadh Shimal.

Detainee recognized the partial photograph of the following MAM as Abu Qaswarah aka Abu Sara aka Abu Jasim.

'Abd-al-Kamil Bin-Ahamad Musawi aka Abu-'Abdallah

Detainee provided physical descriptions for two of the MAM at Abu Qaswarah's tented camp.

Detainee claimed that Abu Abdullah described below was the owner of the tent and the man of associated family since Abu Abdullah went out to get the food.

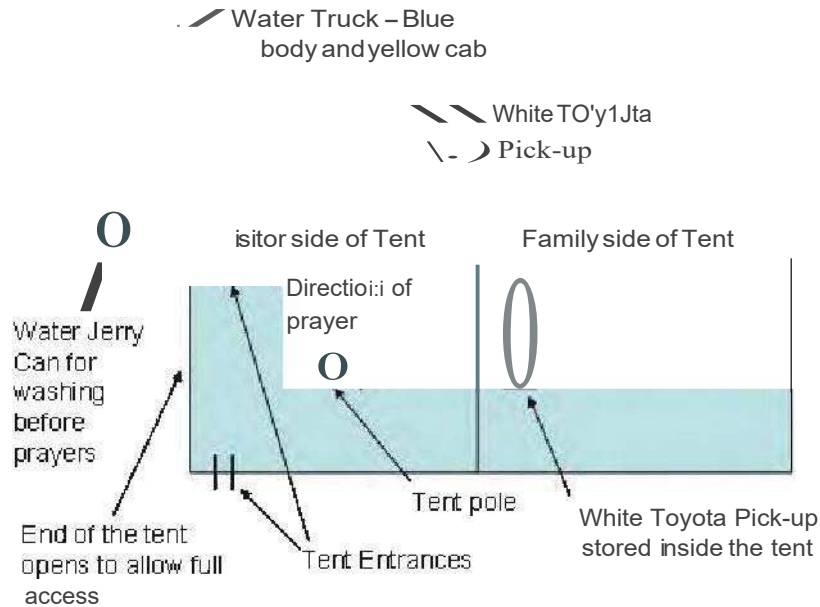

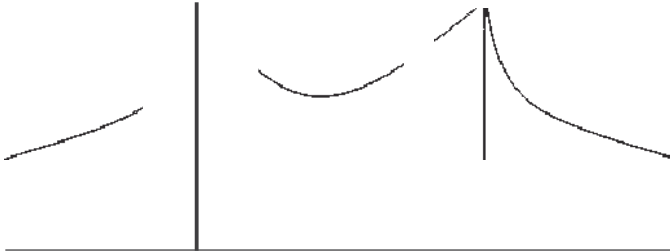

Detainee described the tent as being made from animal hair and provided the following general layout.



Detainee provided the following side view of the tent.



Although the majority of the ISI members who had been to see Abu Qaswarah were from the right (West) side of Mosul, Detainee was aware that a number of members from the left side had also visited Abu Qaswarah. These included: Jasim Abu Ahmed, right side security and Abu Nassir.

These meetings were an opportunity for Abu Qaswarah to meet the various leaders and to gain information on the status of ISI activities in Mosul. Detainee did not believe that Abu Sumaya had met with Abu Qaswarah, at least not after the first 'Event' in Mosul. Detainee did not think that Abu Sumaya was particularly favored by Abu Qaswarah.

Detainee had once heard of (or possibly seen) three ISI Mosul fighters in Abu Arab's car, being driven to meet with Abu Qaswarah.

Jar Allah arrived in Mosul two months [REDACTED] Jar Allah was a Saudi and transported into Mosul by Abu Arab. Detainee was unsure where Jar Allah

started his journey but Detainee believes that Jar Allah may have been in the Jazirah at some point.

Jar Allah was initially placed on the right side of Mosul, in the Shari'a branch, under the direction of Abu Abdullah. After one month Jar Allah was transferred to the right side in order to meet up with some of Jar Allah's Saudi friends who were on the left (east) side. Jar Allah may have had some previous military experience and even though Jar Allah was Shari'a Jar Allah was always seen with the fighters or with Admin.

Jar Allah had a reputation for getting involved, mostly uninvited, in many different affairs such as Admin, Media, military as well as Shari'a. Jar Allah may be favored by the ISI senior leadership since he was tasked with getting experience in a number of areas. Jar Allah's nosy behavior had even managed to get Hajji Anmar, the Wali of Mosul, annoyed.

Detainee had not heard of an individual called Ustadh Shimal, but since the Arabic translation was 'Professor of the North' Detainee speculated that as a title it may refer to an ISI personality from the north of Mosul and as such could possibly refer to Abu Sumaya or Abu Mahmud or Abu Mahir.
