- Detainee identified terrain that was similar to terrain that was present at Abu Qaswarah's Bedouin Camp.
- Detainee explained that Abu Qaswarah must approve any ISI member to travel to Syria.
- Detainee provided information regarding Abu Hind, AKA Abu Qays. Abu Hind was responsible for building a house for Abu Qaswarah in Mosul.

- **Detainee described the frequency of Abu Arab's travel to Jazirah.**

The landscape surrounding Abu Qaswarah's tent and camp was very dry, but not very hilly. There were scattered hills in the distance, and not much shrubbery. The following picture looks very similar to the terrain in the area, although there are not as many hills as depicted. The area immediately near the camp was relatively flat.



Abu Qaswarah must approve any travel to Syria. All members of the ISI in Mosul to include the Wali must have the permission of Abu Qaswarah to travel to Syria. Members requiring travel to Syria for medical reasons needed a doctor's note explaining the reason. Once Abu Qaswarah gave his permission the member would contact the administration section for travel funds. Members would forward and receive all requests through their section amirs. If the member had a relationship with Abu Arab the member could give Abu Arab the note personally for delivery. All notes were folded and wrapped in tape. Abu Arab transported all requests to and from Jazirah.

Abu Hind, AKA Abu Qays, a driver for Abu 'Abdallah al-Shami and Abu Basha'ir, was supposed to build a house for Abu Qaswarah in the Hay al-Hadba area of Mosul. The ISI had already purchased the land for the project. Abu Qays was captured by CF in August or September of 2007 and was unable to complete the project. The land was later sold and the house was never built.

Detainee recalls seeing a camel train of up to 20 camels at a short distance from Abu Qaswarah's Bedouin Camp. Detainee recalls seeing men from Abu Qaswarah's camp feed the camels.
