Content of Request

To the brother, the wali of al-Raqqah, may God grant him steadfastness. Peace be upon you, God’s mercy and His blessings. And as to what follows:

I am sister [redacted]. I am 36 years old. I have 2 children; my son is 11 years old and his name is [redacted] and my daughter’s name is [redacted] and she is 10 years old. My husband’s name is [redacted] and he is 40 years old. He is currently in Turkey and he works in the Land of Two Holy Places [Saudi Arabia]. He came to Turkey in an attempt to enter Syria to see me, but now he can’t enter to meet us because of the stamps on his passport.

I came to Raqqah a month and a half ago, in Ramadan, with a visiting card. I stayed for a month in Raqqah, and when I was about to return to Suluk [a town in northern Raqqah province close to the Syrian borders], I reached a checkpoint, but the brother there tore up the visiting card and asked me to return and said, “This card is old.”

I went to the Hisbah with the recommendation from the brothers.

When my son was asked, he told him [the Hisbah member] that “my father is in Turkey and we want to go to him,” the brother in Hisbah expelled us.

Please solve our problem.
