### Content of Request

To the brother, the wali of al-Raqqah, may God preserve you. Peace be upon you, God’s mercy and His blessings. And as to what follows:

I am brother ‘Ubaydah al-Ansari. My family works with the brothers in the General Supplying. They smuggle weapons to the brothers from areas under the control of the Awakenings [FSA]. My brother had a Shari’ah violation, and thus, he was arrested by the Hisbah, may God help them, and they made him do Shari’ah course. Knowing that he was the one traveling to areas under the control of the Awakenings to bring weapons. My father was penalized by the Hisbah too and they made him do a Shari’ah course, which he finished. They took from my father the Family Book. I ask you, because it is my duty towards God, to accept to return the Family Book and take my brother’s ID instead for the sake of the public interest. I don’t want him to not do the Shari’ah course, rather, I’m the one who insisted on him finishing it so he can learn the correct matters of his religion. And for your information, I did go to the Rumaylah Hisbah office and the brother in charge of handling IDs treated me badly and raised his voice to me, despite the fact that I explained the situation to him with all the details. However, he said to me, “There is no ID exchange allowed.” He claimed that this was the order of the Hisbah’s Nadhir [official]. I have a witness on that, which is brother Abu Ibrahim, who works there. I don’t know the name of the brother in charge of the IDs.
