In the name of Allah, the Gracious, the Merciful

The person named Bashshar with the kunyah (Abu Ishaq) used to work for the al-'Izz Army as an administrator and under Abu Khattab, in al-Sayyidah al-Jamilah course. When they moved from the headquarters, Abu Ishaq took a plasma screen from the headquarters without the knowledge of emir Abu Khattab. When Abu Khattab learned of this, he reprimanded him and said to him, "You have to return the items." He returned it and was expelled from the battalion, as he was transferred to another battalion as a soldier. After a while, he told the brothers that he was working as an administrator, so they made him an administrator in the new battalion in the al-'Usrah Army. Note that Abu Ishaq lived in a house before the conquest, and he was telling the district that he bought the house. Note that the owner of the house was a lawyer and was killed in Baghdad by the brothers. Several months after the conquest, Abu Ishaq pledged bay'a to the [Islamic] State and told the brothers, "I rent the house." I met one of the soldiers of al-'Usrah Army, brother Abu Harith, who is working in the affairs, and he told me that Abu Ishaq lives in the house and pays rent. Note that the house is not rented and this was investigated by the brothers and he admitted it. Hence, he paid the brothers the accumulated rent, which is about one and a half million, and the brothers punished him. He now holds an administrative position in the al-'Usrah Army. Note that Abu Ishaq had a relationship before the conquest with lieutenant Fuad and lieutenant Amjad. I used to see them when they used to visit him at night. Knowing that he used to work as a clerk at the traffic department. The brothers found on Abu Ishaq's personal computer, when he was an administrator, video clips and songs. Brother Abu Harith and a number of brothers in the al-'Usrah Army testify to this.
