Text of the complaint

All praise is due to God. After swearing the oath:

At sunset, Hisbah people raided my house, located in al-Zarqawi Neighborhood near Al-Mustafa Mosque. The way they treated us was the worst ever, and it has nothing to do with the manners of Islam. They entered the house without permission, and we couldn't even cover ourselves, on charges of possession of cigarettes. After they searched the house, they couldn't find anything. They beat my husband, and he is an old man. Even my daughter [end of the page], who is 12 years old passed out from fear. When my husband objected to the way they treated us, and told them, "We thought you had freed us from injustice," they dragged him, beat him, and arrested him. Then, when I objected, one of them said to me, "Shut up or I'll call the women Hisbah for you." They even arrested my husband, [redacted], and my sons, Muhannad and Ra'ad, and they took them bare foot without giving them a chance to wear anything. All that happened while they were harshly beating them.
