I'm your sister, Umm al-Layth ([REDACTED]). I was married to brother Murhaf Abu Ghannam and he was killed. After his death, I moved to Wilayat Raqqah. After I finished my 'Iddah [legal waiting period], I married brother Safi Abu al-Layth ([REDACTED]). Five months later, Safi Abu al-Layth got killed, alongside brother Abu 'Aisha al-Ansar, who was the deputy general military commander of Wilayat Homs. They were killed by a Kornet rocket in Wilayat Homs. I live in Wilayat Raqqah, but the brother in Wilayat Homs has not transferred my name to Wilayat Raqqah. One of my relatives went to ask from Homs embassy and they told him that my name has been transferred to Wilayat Raqqah. Then, after asking from the Martyrs' Office, they said that they have not received my name despite the fact that my husband was killed 3 months ago and I have not received anything. O our sheikh, by God, I'm so tired of this, and I've been begging this and that just to receive my rights, so please help me. Knowing that there are two brothers who went to ask at the Martyrs' Office and the embassies, and are witnesses that he was killed, [and their names are]:

Abu Sayf al-Ghami, who works in the Wounded Office in Wilayat Homs.
Abu Jihad al-Shami, who works in the General Administration in Wilayat Raqqah.

And may God reward you the best.
